TITLE: ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE CITY'S ELECTORAL SYSTEM FROM AT-LARGE TO BY-DISTRICT ELECTIONS WITH RESPECT TO ELECTING MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL, ESTABLISHING BOUNDARIES, AND SEQUENCING OF ELECTIONS WITHIN THE DISTRICTS – SECOND READING

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt an ordinance amending Chapter 1.24 of the Half Moon Bay Municipal Code to change the City's electoral system from at-large to by-district elections with respect to electing members of the City Council, establishing boundaries, and sequencing of elections within the districts.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.

STRATEGIC ELEMENT:

This action supports the Inclusive Governance Element of the Strategic Plan.

DISCUSSION:

On September 4, 2018, the City Council introduced the ordinance following the conduct of a duly-noticed public hearing. As required by law, the ordinance appears for second reading and adoption a regular meeting more than five days past introduction.
