



BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING NOTES

**THURSDAY, JULY 7, 2022
6:30 P.M.**

I. INTRODUCTION

In the absence of a quorum, it was decided no actions would be taken at this meeting and that all agenda items will be presented as informational. Acknowledgement of the May 5th BPAC meeting notes moved to BPAC meeting on September 1, 2022.

II. PUBLIC FORUM – NON-AGENDA ITEMS

There were no members of the public who wished to speak.

III. AGENDA ITEMS

Public Works Director John Doughty provided an update on the operation of e-bikes and other devices on trails and paths, including the topics of speed limits, signage, and a community survey. Assistant Engineer Jonathan Woo provided updates about the Kelly Avenue Complete Streets grant and four other recent grant submittals. The Public Works Director provided updates about the Poplar Parallel Trail and the Smith Field Master Facilities.

Questions/comments/discussion: MR: Great vision. JRD: When would this start? JD: Next summer would be the earliest, we would wait until after the Little League season. We have virtually no debt as a City, we are in a good position to bond, and then make a significant dent in this, with bonding and limited amount of indebtedness in the future. A decision would need to be made whether the City is going to be pay as you go or incur debt. ES: Is there a way to make Smith Field more accessible to people using the trails to the west? JD: Coastside Land Trust entered into an agreement for providing use of right-of-way, however, there are dedicated unimproved subdivided lots in there. The City Manager was given authority to enter into agreements regarding those right of

ways, such as environmental documents, applications for state grants, and working with Coastal Conservancy (parcels to the South of Smith Field). That would connect all the way to Redondo Beach Road, vertical access down to Redondo, and connect down to the Coastal Trail, trying to fix the area to the south between hole 16 and 17 and connecting that; contract in place soon to repair sidewalk behind the Ritz-Carlton and to extend beyond the golf course. We'll see what happens with the Coastside Land Trust Grants.

IV. STAFF ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Kelly Avenue Safety improvements have begun at the Kelly Avenue intersections at Pilarcitos and Alsace Lorraine. The goal is to have the improvements completed before school starts. Regarding the overhead light and signals @ Kelly, about 2.5-3 months ago, a vehicle crashed into the poles; Caltrans got in there quickly with the temporary repairs and has since replaced with new poles.
