10.30.140 Operation of a bicycle or skateboard.

A. The operator of a bicycle, skateboard, or scooter shall obey all vehicular traffic control devices and the applicable laws under the Vehicle Code of the state of California.

B. No person shall ride or operate a bicycle upon any sidewalk or pedestrian walkway or pedestrian mall.

C. No person shall operate a bicycle, skateboard, or scooter on any sidewalk, public plaza, walkway or pedestrian mall in any commercially zoned district in the city.

D. No person shall operate an electric bicycle as defined by the Vehicle Code of the state of California on any equestrian trail or dirt hiking trail.

E. No person shall operate a bicycle, skateboard, scooter, or other device on any trail, or multi-use path, at a speed that exceeds 15 miles per hour and will not exceed 5 miles per hour when passing any pedestrian, equestrian, or a person who is stopped.

F. No Person shall operate a bicycle, skateboard, scooter, or other device on any trail, or multi-use path, at a speed that exceeds 5 miles per hour when within 300 feet of a trailhead, parking lot, or beach access point.

G. Where any provision of this section has been violated by a minor, then in lieu of criminal proceedings ~~the chief of police~~ the City of Half Moon Bay or designee may prohibit the operation of a bicycle ~~or~~ skateboard, or scooter by said minor, in the city for a period of time not to exceed thirty days and in such an event the City of Half Moon Bay or designee ~~chief of police~~ may impound a bicycle ~~or~~ skateboard, or scooter used in any such violation for a period of time not to exceed thirty days. (Ord. **10**-83 §2, 1984).
